- You will find a sheet to write the names of your family members you want to be prayed for during the month of November, the lists are put in a box on the steps of the altar during this month.

- •Buy the way, we wish to start a fund for supporting vocations. Our parish is blessed with many vocations, and we thank God for that. However it is good for the parishioners to know that when we send a youth to the seminary or for religious life, we should pay school fees for each. The cost is of one million Kes per year for each not including plane tickets. We wanted our faithful to be aware of that and understand why we desire to establish a fund for vocations.

Plenary Indulgence of 2 November:

From 12 noon on 1 November until midnight on 2 November one plenary indulgence (applicable only to the Holy Souls) may be gained by visiting a church or oratory and recite the *Our Father* and the *Creed* there.

Conditions for gaining a plenary indulgence:

Go to Confession (in the week preceding or the week following 1 November)

Receive Holy Communion (1 Holy Communion for each indulgence) See here, no 20, § 2

Pray for the Pope's intentions (one *Our Father*, and *Hail Mary* or any other prayer of one's choice)

One should have the desire to be detached from every attraction to sin, even the slightest

Plenary Indulgence 1 - 8 November

The faithful who **visit a cemetery and pray for the dead**, may gain a plenary indulgence (applicable only to the Holy Souls) **once per day** from 1 to 8 November.

The above conditions regarding Confession, Holy Communion and prayer for the Pope's intentions apply also for this.s
